He is experienced in Confiscation Act matters both in the drafting of applications and in courtroom advocacy.

He has previously served on the Bar Council Executive. He has served multiple terms on the committee of the Criminal Bar Association and has edited the CBA newsletter. He served on the working group planning and implementing the Indictable Crime Certificate.

Justin has been a leading counsel for Victoria Legal Aid's Trial Counsel Development Program since 2011.
