Most recently, he was appointed to the Panel of Conciliators at the International Centre for the Settlement of Investment Disputes (ICSID) at Washington, USA and is recognised internationally as a leading arbitrator on domain name disputes.

He has practiced in virtually every area of the law, including commercial, construction, intellectual property, administrative, town planning, and industrial relations. He now concentrates on mediation, arbitration and

advice.

He has also taken part in three significant inquiries on behalf of the Commonwealth Government, concerning a banking matter, a military inquiry and a constitutional review. He regularly gives advice on contentious matters and acts as a case evaluator.
